Ron Ranson is an English artist, teacher and prolific author. He is one of the world's most traveled watercolor teachers and has given workshops and private instruction all over the world. Needless to say, he is a man of great patience and good English humor.

Ron's style is impressionistic and traditionalist and his work is renowned for its purity of design and clear, transparent colors. He paints decisively and quickly using his own version of the oriental hake brush. He is a master of timing.

Ron encourages freedom of expression and simplicity. In this PAL-sponsored workshop, students will learn techniques for producing strong, effective value sketches. The eight principles of design will be stressed, focusing on how best to use them in creating good paintings.

Specifically, he will demonstrate watercolor techniques for producing various types of cloud formations, based on two of the more than 25 books he has written.

Ron also writes articles for art magazines in England, Holland, Norway and Australia, and has been the European editor of the prestigious publication, International Artist Magazine.
